The Foundation is proud to continue to honor Doug's legacy through this scholarship designed to provide financial support to NSCC students. Recipients are awarded a maximum of \$ 500.00 each year. Funds can be applied towards tuition, textbooks, DCM charges, and ecampus fees. Awards will be made contingent upon available funding.

Scholarships are awarded to qualified applicants based on the following criteria and the recommendation of NSCC Student Success Advisors or Reconnect Navigators.

To qualify, please submit your NSCC Financial Aid and Scholarship Form through your myNSCC. You must complete this form each year by May 31st. We recommend that you submit your form early.

This scholarship is awarded to qualified applicants based on the following criteria:

- Applicants must be at least 18 years old and attending/enrolled to attend Nashville State.
- Applicants must be working with an NSCC Student Success Advisor or a Tennessee Reconnect Navigator.
- Applicants must be enrolled in a minimum of 6 credit hours.
- If an applicant has previously completed college-level coursework, applicant must have earned a 2.0 cumulative grade point average
- Applicants must be in good academic standing and meet satisfactory academic progress standards, as measured for federal Title IV Programs.
- Applicants must complete the Free Application for Federal Student Aid (FAFSA).

Applicable maintenance fee/tuition refunds will be credited to the scholarship except in cases when the student is also receiving federal Title IV benefits and totally withdraws. In such cases, the refund is credited back to the appropriate program(s) according to the NSCC "Return of Title IV Funds" Policy.
